The "Inclusive Employment for Youth - HUMAN JOBS" project aims to achieve an increase in the employment rate of NEETs ("Not in Employment, Education or Training") and young people with minor physical disabilities, increasing their confidence, their motivation and reducing anxiety related to job search, the application process and the first days of work. The project also aims to promote employment in the humanities as inclusive employability, empowering NEETs and young people with minor physical disabilities and creating an effective and sustainable practice that can be multiplied.

OBJECTIVES

- Increase of employment rate in NEETs and young people with slight physical disabilities
- Promotion of jobs in humanities sector as is inclusive employability, empowering NEETs and young people with slight physical disabilities
- Creating an effective, sustainable practice which can be multiplied

ACTIVITIES

- Research activities aimed at drawing up a career development plan in the field of human sciences and mapping the barriers that exist for access to those careers;
- Development of an interactive, educational and job search platform in the humanities;
- Organization of events and scientific production.
