WHAT IS S-DIY?

A quick recap

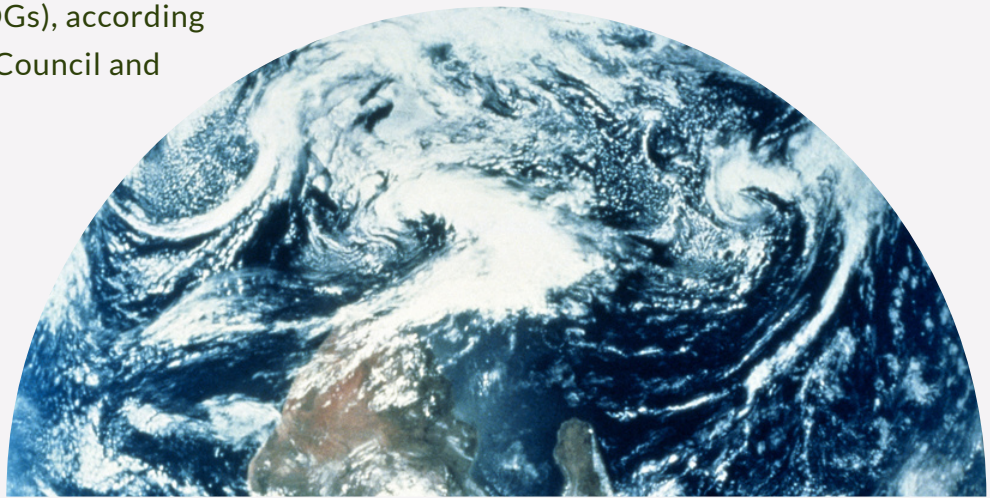
The Project aims to promote active engagement in EU and global citizenship and lead to contribute to the EU's implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), according to the priorities dictated by the EU Council and EU youth policy.

The S-DIY project promotes youth training on the SDGs and environmental sustainability to strengthen its sense of initiative by addressing four main objectives:

- Record best practices on how to promote inclusive dialogue among youth from different social groups, including minorities;
- Record best practices on how to promote youth debate on international sustainability and active EU/global citizenship;
- Raise interest in the SDGs and their implementation in the EU among youth from diverse backgrounds;
- Test an inclusive simulation model on the implementation of the SDGs in the EU.

The following outcomes are instrumental in achieving the overall objectives:


- Development of a dialogue platform on environmental sustainability goals.
- Implementation of public debates.

DEBATES



The S-DIY initiative intends to incite a diverse discussion among young people from all backgrounds in an effort to represent all of the voices of modern society in one place. In addition, S-DIY seeks to educate young people on how the EU is implementing the SDGs in order for them to develop creative ideas that may be presented to EU and UN decision-makers through ad hoc channels.



The partners are planning public discussions in their nations based on the information on the e-platforms to give young people training possibilities.

With the use of the E-platform's SDGs and active citizenship in the EU content, the partners conducted workshops for youth as a pre-event activity.



These discussions' purpose is to allow the young people working on the project to put what they've learned on the platform into practice and engage in experiential learning.

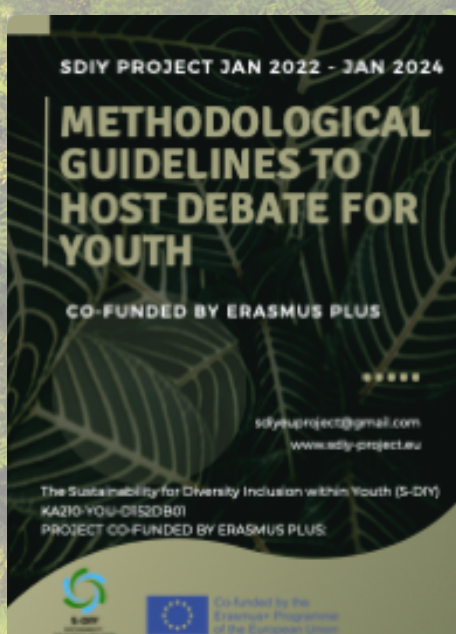
Let's take a look on what the partnership did up till now!

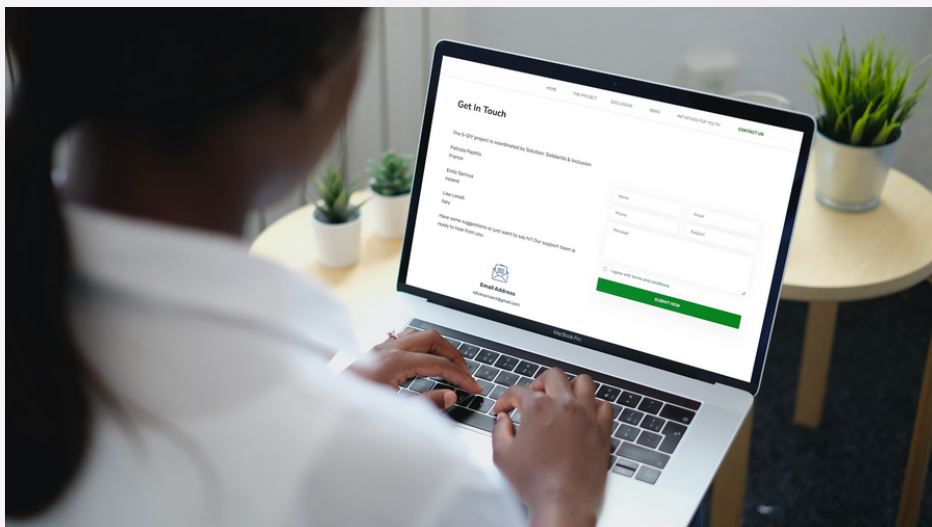
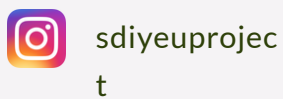
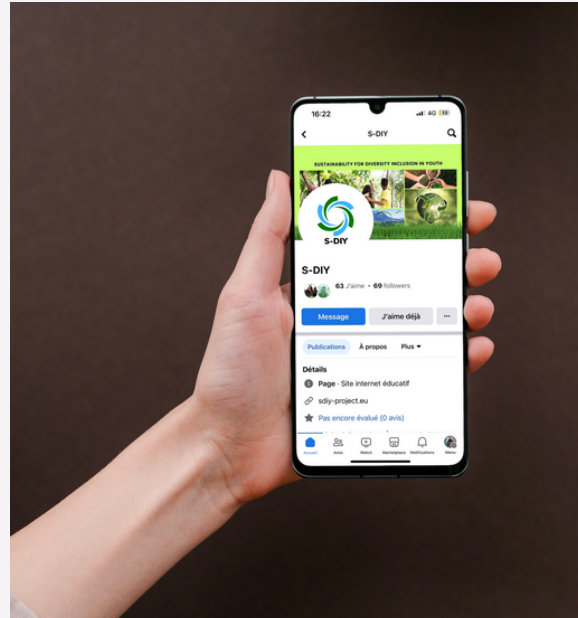
DEBATES
